Other business


Nat Smith presented a proposal to be sent to the planning commission so it could be fully executed as soon as possible, before people think that the Boester /Wright appeal sets a new precedent for further building on the water's edge. The following is a copy of the proposal:


The Greensboro Development Review Board (DRB), at its duly warned organizational meeting on September 23, 2019, decided unanimously to urge the Planning Commission to adopt the following amendment to Greensboro's Zoning By-Law: **No structure, or part of a structure, within 25 feet of Caspian Lake may have its height increased** (with the singular exception that a boathouse, with DRB approval, may have its height raised to 15 feet, the height allowed for new boathouses.) The DRB hopes that this amendment can be voted on at the town meeting in early 2020.

The Board voted unanimously to approve this proposal and directed Nat to send it to the planning commission.
